You can get to the venue in various ways. Since Munich has an excellent public transportation system (trains, subways, trams, and buses), we would recommend making use of public transport. Most locations within the city can be reached within less than 30 min.

- The underground station "Odeonsplatz" is located next to the venue and is frequented by underground lines U3, U4, U5, and U6.
- Tickets can be bought at automatic vending machines at underground and train stations or inside buses and trams.
- For specific information on public transportation schedules, please check Munich's public transportation company MVV, Google Maps or download the MVV mobile journey planner.

From Munich Airport

From the airport, take the S1 or S8 train to the city and get off at "Marienplatz". From there, it is a 10 min walk.

From Munich Central Station

From the central station, take any S-Bahn, heading to "Ostbahnhof", and get off at "Marienplatz". From there, it is a 10 min walk. Another possibility is to take the subway U4 or U5 and get off at "Odeonsplatz".
